



It's September, and the weather is gradually beginning to change after a long, hot summer. I love this time of year and enjoy watching the leaves turn golden before they fall.

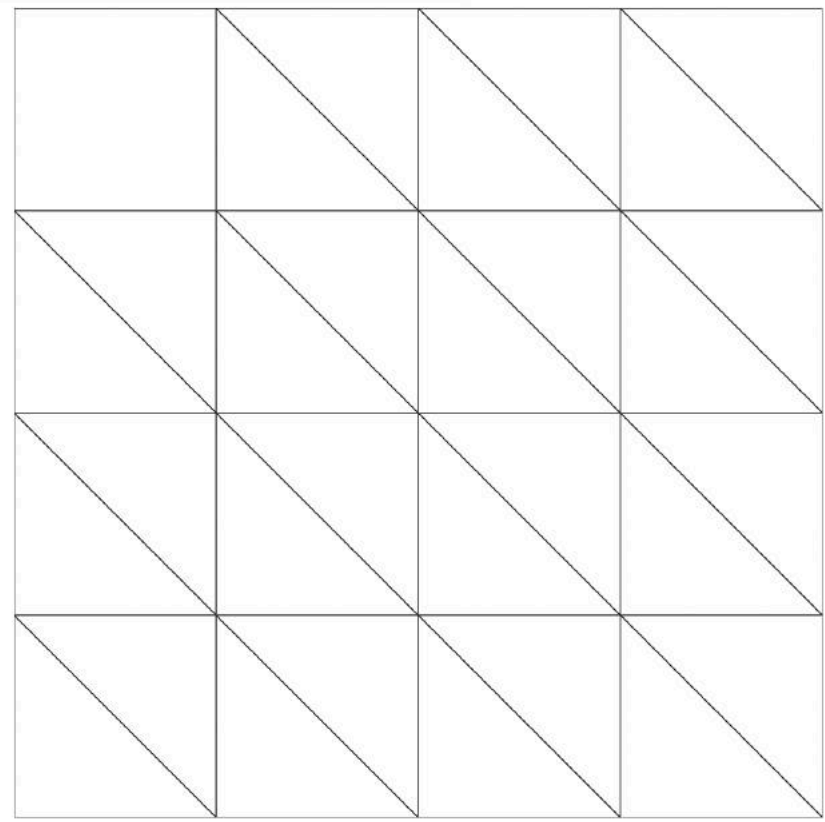
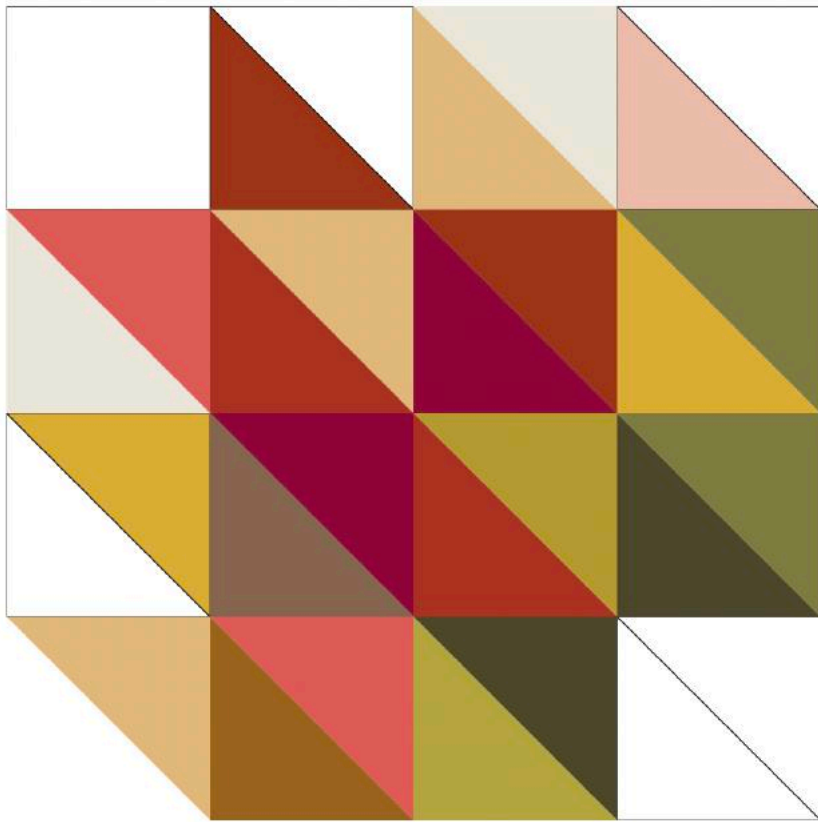
I've been looking forward to making this square. Natural greens, rusts and golds are amongst my favourite colours, and I am drawn to use them in most of my crochet designs. This means I had lots of scraps to choose from. My favourite yarn in this square is the deep burgundy shade. It's James C Brett Marble and has all the other Autumn shades running through it.

I've saved my brighter rust and orange yarns for October. I expect you can guess what that square will be!

Here is my layout for September, and a blank for you to try out your own scheme with the colours you have in your stash.





I've added a stalk to my leaf. This is simply long slip stitches added to the surface of the finished square. Make your slip stitches corner to corner in the spaces of the granny square.
